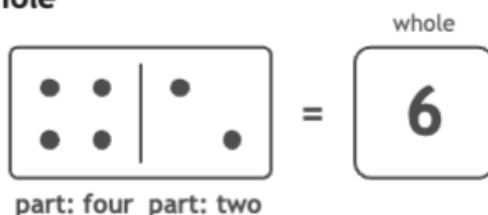


Parts on Dice & Dominoes

Represent part-part-whole relationships to ten with dominoes and dice. Recognise each standard dot pattern as a part, then combine the two parts to name the whole — no counting by ones.

Two parts make the whole



Four dots and two dots are the parts — together they make six.

Read the parts, name the whole

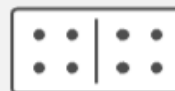
Subitise each standard pattern, then combine the two parts.



3 and 2 = 5



5 and 1 = 6



4 and 4 = 8

Roll two dice

Read each die pattern, then say the whole the two make.

Read a domino

Name the parts on each half and combine to the whole.

Say the two parts you see inside a standard pattern.
