On Country

Notice repeats in nature
— rows of shells, ripples
in the sand, lines in bark.

Necklaces

Shell and seed necklaces
repeat colours, shapes
and sizes in order.

Dance & song

Dances and songs repeat
steps, claps and beats in
time.

Thread a shell and seed necklace — what has been repeated?



“shell, seed, shell, seed — a repeating unit of two”

Clap the beat of a song together
and name the repeat.
