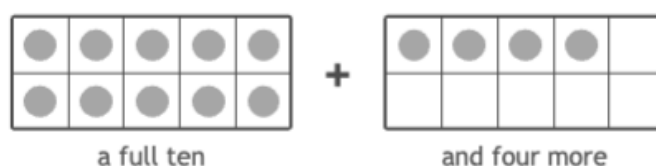


Count & Compare to 20

Quantify and compare larger collections up to 20 by counting in groups and using ten-frames – then explain the reasoning for which collection has more.

Make ten, then count on



10 and 4 more is 14 – count on from ten instead of starting at one.

SPOTLIGHT Compare, then explain why

Count each collection in rows of five, compare the totals, then say why one has more.

15 is more than 10 – it has one extra row of five counters.



Count the collection

Count large sets in groups of five or ten, not by ones.



Build on ten-frames

Fill ten-frames to see tens and leftovers to 20.



Compare & explain

Compare two sets and say why one has more or fewer.
