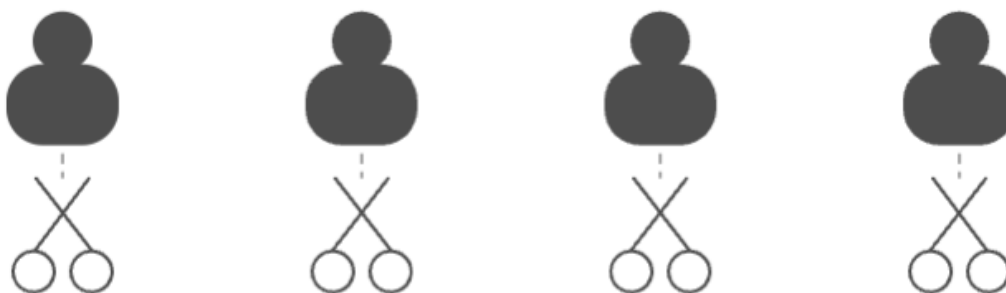


Count to Collect Enough

Use counting and one-to-one correspondence to work out how many are needed: count the people, then collect the same number of items so everyone has one.

One for each: match people to scissors



4 people → collect 4 pairs of scissors

How to collect just enough

1

Count the group

Count each person once.

2

One for each

Match one item to each person.

3

Collect that many

The total tells how many to get.

Set the table

Count the places, then collect a cup and plate for each.

Hand out materials

Count the group, then bring one glue or brush per person.

Match and check

Line items up with people to check there is one each.
