explore how language is used differently at home and school depending on the relationships between people

Learning intention

- explore how language is used differently at home and school depending on the relationships between people

Teach and model

- asking relevant questions, and expressing requests and opinions in ways that suit the contexts
- learning to use language according to the relationship between people; for example, between a parent and a child, a teacher and a student, siblings or friends, shopkeepers...

Check understanding

- Explain the main idea in how language is used differently at home and school depending... using an example.
- Show the idea in a second way: with words, a model, a diagram or symbols.
- Apply the idea to a short unfamiliar situation and justify the result.

Teaching cautions

- Ask the student to explain their choice, not only state an answer.
- Check that key vocabulary is understood in a new example.
- Mix representations so the skill is transferred rather than copied.

Quick lesson sequence

- Connect to prior knowledge and introduce the key vocabulary.
- Model one clear example, then solve a second example together.
- Finish with an independent check and a short student explanation.
