Learning intention

- understand conventions of print and screen, including how books and simple digital texts are usually organised

Teach and model

- learning that Standard Australian English in written texts is read from left to right and usually from top to bottom of the page
- identifying tabs in a digital text
- discussing the placement of images and words in text

Check understanding

- Explain the main idea in conventions of print and screen, including how books and simple... using an example.
- Show the idea in a second way: with words, a model, a diagram or symbols.
- Apply the idea to a short unfamiliar situation and justify the result.

Teaching cautions

- Ask the student to explain their choice, not only state an answer.
- Check that key vocabulary is understood in a new example.
- Mix representations so the skill is transferred rather than copied.

Quick lesson sequence

- Connect to prior knowledge and introduce the key vocabulary.
- Model one clear example, then solve a second example together.
- Finish with an independent check and a short student explanation.
