

Interact in informal and structured situations by listening while others...

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Learning intention

- interact in informal and structured situations by listening while others speak and using features of voice including volume levels

Teach and model

- exchanging ideas with peers in pairs and small groups, engaging in class discussions, listening to others and contributing ideas
- showing understanding of appropriate listening behaviour, such as listening without interrupting, and looking at the speaker, if culturally appropriate
- altering volume for inside and outside situations and when speaking to an audience

Check understanding

- Explain the main idea in interact in informal and structured situations by listening while others... using an example.
- Show the idea in a second way: with words, a model, a diagram or symbols.
- Apply the idea to a short unfamiliar situation and justify the result.

Teaching cautions

- Ask the student to explain their choice, not only state an answer.
- Check that key vocabulary is understood in a new example.
- Mix representations so the skill is transferred rather than copied.

Quick lesson sequence

- Connect to prior knowledge and introduce the key vocabulary.
- Model one clear example, then solve a second example together.
- Finish with an independent check and a short student explanation.
