

Look Closer with a Magnifier

Use a magnifying glass or a camera to observe the small external features of plants and animals – seeds, leaf veins, legs and wings.

Zoom in

Use a magnifier or a camera.

Observe

Look at the tiny features.

Record

Draw or name what you see.

A closer look reveals more features.
