

Part-Part-Whole — Answer Key

Q1 15

Parts 9 and 6 join to make the whole: $9 + 6 = 15$.

Q2 8

Whole 13 take away the known part 5 leaves 8.

Q3 14

Parts 6 and 8 make 14. Near double: double 6 is 12, add 2 more.

Q4 6

Take one part away and the other part is left, so $14 - 8 = 6$.

Q5 8

Whole 17, part 9, so the other part is 8.

Q6 7

The whole is 11 and one part is 4, so the part taken away is 7.

Q7 See diagram

Whole box 16 on top, parts 9 and 7 below. Check $9 + 7 = 16$.

Q8 $5+7, 7+5, 12-7, 12-5$

Two add facts and two take away facts from whole 12, parts 5 and 7.

Q9 $15 - 8 = 7$ · ENRICH

Sam used a double. The whole is 15, so taking 8 away leaves 7.

Q10 Same three numbers · ENRICH

One whole and two parts make four facts, read two ways each.
