

Two Ways to Divide — Answer Key

Q1 4

12 shared into 3 equal groups gives 4 counters in each group.

Q2 4 groups

Making groups of 3 from 12 counters gives 4 groups.

Q3 4

$12 \div 3 = 4$, and this answers both questions.

Q4 3

15 shared into 5 equal groups gives 3 pencils in each group.

Q5 3

$15 \div 5 = 3$, so each group has 3 pencils.

Q6 5

20 counters in groups of 4 makes 5 groups.

Q7 6

18 shared between 3 friends gives 6 stickers each.

Q8 4 groups of 3

Twelve counters ringed in threes make 4 rings.

Q9 No • ENRICH

Sharing tells how many in each group; grouping tells how many groups.

Q10 Both give 4 • ENRICH

Sharing 24 between 6 gives 4 each; making groups of 6 from 24 gives 4 groups.
