

Literary texts and share responses by making connections with students'...

discuss literary texts and share responses by making connections with students' own experiences

Learning intention

- discuss literary texts and share responses by making connections with students' own experiences

Teach and model

- generating questions about characters, settings and events from books and sharing responses
- discussing different texts and offering opinions about how they reflect their own experiences
- expressing responses to characters and events in stories using drawing and role-play

Check understanding

- Explain the main idea in literary texts and share responses by making connections with students'... using an example.
- Show the idea in a second way: with words, a model, a diagram or symbols.
- Apply the idea to a short unfamiliar situation and justify the result.

Teaching cautions

- Ask the student to explain their choice, not only state an answer.
- Check that key vocabulary is understood in a new example.
- Mix representations so the skill is transferred rather than copied.

Quick lesson sequence

- Connect to prior knowledge and introduce the key vocabulary.
- Model one clear example, then solve a second example together.
- Finish with an independent check and a short student explanation.
