Learning Intention: I can describe a familiar journey across Country/Place using direction words.

1. Know the Route

Think of a journey you know.
home to school, or to a park
picture each part of the way.

2. Direction Words

Describe the way.
forwards, left, right, turn
past, towards, until.

3. Tell the Journey

Say each step in order.
'Go straight, then turn...'
landmarks help along the way.

Model It

From home I walk forwards past the big tree, turn right at the river, then keep going straight until the school.
