

Position in a Line

AC9M1SP02_E3 Following directions to move people into positions within a line using ordinal and positional language; for example comparing heights and lining up in height order.

Learning Intention: I can use ordinal and positional words to move people into a line.

1. Ordinal Words

Words that show order:

first, second, third
fourth, fifth, last.

2. Position Words

Words that show where:

in front of, behind
next to, between.

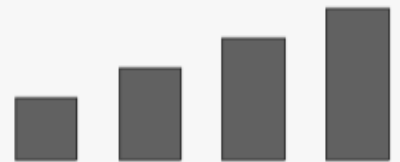
3. Line Up

Follow directions to move.

'Stand behind Sam.'
line up in height order.

Model It

Line up shortest to tallest: Ana is first, Ben is second, and Cam is third and last, standing behind Ben.
