Learning Intention: I can read, write, name and order two-digit numbers from 0 to 120.

1. Read & Name Numerals

16 = sixteen 60 = sixty

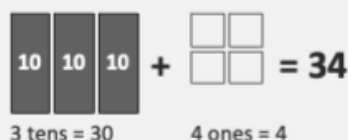
61 = sixty-one 66 = sixty-six

Ones: one, two, three, four, five, six, seven, eight, nine, ten

Tens: twenty, thirty, forty, fifty, sixty, seventy, eighty, ninety, one hundred

2. Tens and Ones

34 = 3 tens and 4 ones



3. Order Look-Alikes

13 ≠ 30 15 ≠ 50

16 ≠ 60 61 ≠ 16

Same sound, different tens.

Remember

Teen = ten and some more
(16, 61, 66 ...)

16 = 10 + 6

Ty = groups of ten
(60, 66, 90 ...)
