WORKED EXAMPLE

Seasonal changes affect plants and animals in many ways. In autumn many trees lose their leaves, and in spring new leaves and flowers grow. When winter comes, some animals hibernate — they sleep through the cold. Others migrate — they travel a long way to find warmer weather and food.
