WORKED EXAMPLE

People choose their clothes by thinking about the weather and the season. If we predict rain, we wear a raincoat and gumboots and take an umbrella. On a hot summer day we choose a sunhat, sunglasses, and cool, light clothes. In winter, when it is cold, we put on a warm coat, a beanie, and gloves. Checking the weather helps us pick the right clothes to stay comfortable and safe.
