WORKED EXAMPLE

Changes in the weather affect plants, animals, and people. When it rains, plants get water to grow and we use umbrellas. On hot, sunny days animals rest in the shade and we wear hats and drink more water. When it is cold, we put on warm clothes and some animals grow thicker fur. In windy, stormy weather, animals and people find shelter to stay safe.
