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Learning intention

- analyse how text structure, language features, literary devices and intertextual connections shape interpretations of texts

Teach and model

- examining a range of short poems, a short story, or extracts from a novel or film to find and discuss examples of how language devices layer meaning and influence the...
- examining satirical representations of events or ideas and determining how satire shapes interpretations and responses

Check understanding

- Explain the main idea in analyse how text structure, language features, literary devices and intertextual... using an example.
- Show the idea in a second way: with words, a model, a diagram or symbols.
- Apply the idea to a short unfamiliar situation and justify the result.

Teaching cautions

- Ask the student to explain their choice, not only state an answer.
- Check that key vocabulary is understood in a new example.
- Mix representations so the skill is transferred rather than copied.

Quick lesson sequence

- Connect to prior knowledge and introduce the key vocabulary.
- Model one clear example, then solve a second example together.
- Finish with an independent check and a short student explanation.
