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Learning intention

- integrate comprehension strategies such as visualising, predicting, connecting, summarising, monitoring, questioning and inferring to analyse and interpret complex...

Teach and model

- monitoring the language features associated with right and wrong in a text and interpreting the representation of the abstract concept of justice
- interpreting how visual features represent abstract concepts in advertising, such as the representation of parenthood in advertisements
- summarising the qualities and interpreting the role of a character archetype in a range of texts and analysing the importance of this archetype

Check understanding

- Explain the main idea in integrate comprehension strategies such as visualising, predicting, connecting, summarising, monitoring... using an...
- Show the idea in a second way: with words, a model, a diagram or symbols.
- Apply the idea to a short unfamiliar situation and justify the result.

Teaching cautions

- Ask the student to explain their choice, not only state an answer.
- Check that key vocabulary is understood in a new example.
- Mix representations so the skill is transferred rather than copied.

Quick lesson sequence

- Connect to prior knowledge and introduce the key vocabulary.
- Model one clear example, then solve a second example together.
- Finish with an independent check and a short student explanation.
