identify how similar topics and information are presented in different types of texts

Learning intention

- identify how similar topics and information are presented in different types of texts

Teach and model

- reading a poem, narrative and informative text about lifecycles and discussing what is learnt
- exploring recipes presented on food packets, in recipe books, in short video clips and in a digital form, noting their shared purpose

Check understanding

- Explain the main idea in how similar topics and information are presented in different types... using an example.
- Show the idea in a second way: with words, a model, a diagram or symbols.
- Apply the idea to a short unfamiliar situation and justify the result.

Teaching cautions

- Ask the student to explain their choice, not only state an answer.
- Check that key vocabulary is understood in a new example.
- Mix representations so the skill is transferred rather than copied.

Quick lesson sequence

- Connect to prior knowledge and introduce the key vocabulary.
- Model one clear example, then solve a second example together.
- Finish with an independent check and a short student explanation.
