Learning intention

- identify aspects of literary texts that represent details or information about historical, social and cultural contexts in literature by First Nations Australian, and...

Teach and model

- identifying aspects of literature; for example, images, symbols, dialogue and character descriptions, that can convey information about a context
- exploring characters and concepts in ballads from different times by wide-ranging Australian authors

Check understanding

- Explain the main idea in aspects of literary texts that represent details or information about... using an example.
- Show the idea in a second way: with words, a model, a diagram or symbols.
- Apply the idea to a short unfamiliar situation and justify the result.

Teaching cautions

- Ask the student to explain their choice, not only state an answer.
- Check that key vocabulary is understood in a new example.
- Mix representations so the skill is transferred rather than copied.

Quick lesson sequence

- Connect to prior knowledge and introduce the key vocabulary.
- Model one clear example, then solve a second example together.
- Finish with an independent check and a short student explanation.
