describe the ways in which a text reflects the time and place in which it was created

Learning intention

- describe the ways in which a text reflects the time and place in which it was created

Teach and model

- describing how ideas in texts are conveyed by vocabulary, including idiomatic expressions, and that these can change according to time and place
- describing how ideas in texts reflect the social expectations of the time and place in which they were created

Check understanding

- Explain the main idea in the ways in which a text reflects the time and... using an example.
- Show the idea in a second way: with words, a model, a diagram or symbols.
- Apply the idea to a short unfamiliar situation and justify the result.

Teaching cautions

- Ask the student to explain their choice, not only state an answer.
- Check that key vocabulary is understood in a new example.
- Mix representations so the skill is transferred rather than copied.

Quick lesson sequence

- Connect to prior knowledge and introduce the key vocabulary.
- Model one clear example, then solve a second example together.
- Finish with an independent check and a short student explanation.
