identify similarities and differences in literary texts on similar topics, themes or plots

Learning intention

- identify similarities and differences in literary texts on similar topics, themes or plots

Teach and model

- exploring texts on a similar topic by authors with very different styles; for example, comparing fantasy quest novels or realistic novels on a specific theme
- identifying differences in the use of narrator, narrative structure and voice, and language and visual features, between texts and determining how these influence readers or...

Check understanding

- Explain the main idea in similarities and differences in literary texts on similar topics, themes... using an example.
- Show the idea in a second way: with words, a model, a diagram or symbols.
- Apply the idea to a short unfamiliar situation and justify the result.

Teaching cautions

- Ask the student to explain their choice, not only state an answer.
- Check that key vocabulary is understood in a new example.
- Mix representations so the skill is transferred rather than copied.

Quick lesson sequence

- Connect to prior knowledge and introduce the key vocabulary.
- Model one clear example, then solve a second example together.
- Finish with an independent check and a short student explanation.
