Learning intention

- discuss the aesthetic and social value of literary texts using relevant and appropriate metalanguage

Teach and model

- determining criteria for evaluating the aesthetic value of a literary text and share opinions
- comparing a film adaptation of a literary text using specific language for naming the text structure, literary devices and language features of film and novels, and sharing...

Check understanding

- Explain the main idea in the aesthetic and social value of literary texts using relevant... using an example.
- Show the idea in a second way: with words, a model, a diagram or symbols.
- Apply the idea to a short unfamiliar situation and justify the result.

Teaching cautions

- Ask the student to explain their choice, not only state an answer.
- Check that key vocabulary is understood in a new example.
- Mix representations so the skill is transferred rather than copied.

Quick lesson sequence

- Connect to prior knowledge and introduce the key vocabulary.
- Model one clear example, then solve a second example together.
- Finish with an independent check and a short student explanation.
