

Analyse and evaluate the ways that language features vary according...

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Learning intention

- analyse and evaluate the ways that language features vary according to the purpose and audience of the text, and the ways that sources and quotations are used...

Teach and model

- evaluating an author's use of language features to present an opinion about those features
- evaluating the use of sources and quotations and presenting an opinion about how an author has supported an idea

Check understanding

- Explain the main idea in analyse and evaluate the ways that language features vary according... using an example.
- Show the idea in a second way: with words, a model, a diagram or symbols.
- Apply the idea to a short unfamiliar situation and justify the result.

Teaching cautions

- Ask the student to explain their choice, not only state an answer.
- Check that key vocabulary is understood in a new example.
- Mix representations so the skill is transferred rather than copied.

Quick lesson sequence

- Connect to prior knowledge and introduce the key vocabulary.
- Model one clear example, then solve a second example together.
- Finish with an independent check and a short student explanation.
