Learning intention

- analyse the representations of people and places in literary texts, drawn from historical, social and cultural contexts, by First Nations Australian, and wide-ranging...

Teach and model

- exploring and comparing representations of values of characters; for example, exploring the values associated with authority, community and family in literature drawn...
- exploring the way wide-ranging Australian novels, poems and films represent water and characters' relationships with water

Check understanding

- Explain the main idea in analyse the representations of people and places in literary texts... using an example.
- Show the idea in a second way: with words, a model, a diagram or symbols.
- Apply the idea to a short unfamiliar situation and justify the result.

Teaching cautions

- Ask the student to explain their choice, not only state an answer.
- Check that key vocabulary is understood in a new example.
- Mix representations so the skill is transferred rather than copied.

Quick lesson sequence

- Connect to prior knowledge and introduce the key vocabulary.
- Model one clear example, then solve a second example together.
- Finish with an independent check and a short student explanation.
