

Analyse the effect of text structures, language features and literary...

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Learning intention

- analyse the effect of text structures, language features and literary devices such as extended metaphor, metonymy, allegory, symbolism and intertextual references

Teach and model

- examining how different authors make use of devices such as imagery, and explaining the effect of these choices on audiences
- identifying examples of literary devices in a range of poems and considering how they contribute to meaning and influence the emotional responses of the audience

Check understanding

- Explain the main idea in analyse the effect of text structures, language features and literary... using an example.
- Show the idea in a second way: with words, a model, a diagram or symbols.
- Apply the idea to a short unfamiliar situation and justify the result.

Teaching cautions

- Ask the student to explain their choice, not only state an answer.
- Check that key vocabulary is understood in a new example.
- Mix representations so the skill is transferred rather than copied.

Quick lesson sequence

- Connect to prior knowledge and introduce the key vocabulary.
- Model one clear example, then solve a second example together.
- Finish with an independent check and a short student explanation.
