analyse the organisation of ideas in paragraphs and extended texts, and evaluate its impact on meaning

Learning intention

- analyse the organisation of ideas in paragraphs and extended texts, and evaluate its impact on meaning

Teach and model

- evaluating techniques used in texts to organise ideas and evoke emotional responses, such as comparison, contrast, exaggeration, juxtaposition, the changing of...
- explaining whether the author conveys meaning effectively, through the sequence of information and evidence

Check understanding

- Explain the main idea in analyse the organisation of ideas in paragraphs and extended texts... using an example.
- Show the idea in a second way: with words, a model, a diagram or symbols.
- Apply the idea to a short unfamiliar situation and justify the result.

Teaching cautions

- Ask the student to explain their choice, not only state an answer.
- Check that key vocabulary is understood in a new example.
- Mix representations so the skill is transferred rather than copied.

Quick lesson sequence

- Connect to prior knowledge and introduce the key vocabulary.
- Model one clear example, then solve a second example together.
- Finish with an independent check and a short student explanation.
